new supporters, and a wealth of new projects and programs to better serve our Laguna. Among these additions, Dr. Wendy Trowbridge joined our staff as Director of Restoration and Conservation Programs. Wendy received her Ph.D. at UC Davis and was research faculty at the University of Nevada. The scope of her scientific expertise (especially her understanding of ecology and ecosystem functions) is crucial as we tackle the most pressing issues facing the Laguna such as water quality, groundwater resources and climate adaptation strategies.

This report summarizes current and future restoration, conservation science and education programs. It also acknowledges the many partnerships and collaborations we have with residents, landowners, the agricultural and business community, government agencies and other non-profit groups. Thank you to everyone whose name is listed in this report. You make all the work possible and we believe it is important to acknowledge everyone who sustains our ongoing work. Donations of every size allow us to move forward with confidence, and larger Leadership Circle gifts enable us to work at a scale broad enough to address the urgent needs to protect the 254-square mile Laguna Watershed.

As we approach 2016, we are invigorated and inspired by the tremendous potential of working in the largest freshwater wetlands complex on the northern California coast. The Laguna watershed stretches from Windsor to Cotati, from Hood Mountain to the hills of Sebastopol, and includes all of Santa Rosa. P.S. Although our new Executive Director, Kevin Munroe, didn't join us until August (two months after this report's timeframe), he is excited to be part of such a dynamic, productive and community-based organization. We'll hear more from Kevin in the next annual report, in the coming issues of *Meanderings* and at upcoming programs and events.

There are many ecological challenges facing the Laguna de Santa Rosa watershed. To address these challenges, the Restoration and Conservation Science Department broadened its scope and focused its work in five areas:

## Water Quality

• Wetlands act as important filters protecting the water quality of the Laguna. Over the past year, we planted, maintained or monitored over one thousand wetland plantings on 76 acres at six different sites. Plantings will begin on an additional three sites in 2016.

• In partnership with the San Francisco Estuary Institute, we expanded our Historical Ecology Study of the Laguna de Santa Rosa to document the historical extent of wetlands, the riparian corridor, and land use changes over time in the Laguna main channel and surrounds. This study will help inform our work to better restore the Laguna wetlands.

• We were involved with the development of a water quality credit trading system to offset potential nutrient releases into the Laguna.

• In partnership with Prunuske Chatham, Inc. and the City of Sebastopol we drafted the Laguna Wetlands Preserve Restoration and Management Plan. With significant public input, the Plan outlines the important resources of the Preserve and suggestions to guide long-term management and restoration opportunities in this highly visible and popular area.

### **Invasive Species**

• We completed a multi-year study in Sebastopol's Laguna Wetlands Preserve testing the efficacy of tarping vs. herbicide to control perennial pepperweed. Since neither control technique was 100% effective we will continue to evaluate other best practices in the Laguna for invasive species control.

 Interns remapped three major invasive species in the middle reach (Hwy 12 – Occidental Rd.) creating a map that can be used to track their abundance over time and compare their extent in 2006 when the original mapping was completed.

• Our long-term goal is to collaborate with major land owners in the middle reach to create a collaborative plan for invasive species management including grazing, restoring native grasses and an integrated pest management strategy.

• We expanded our Native Plant Nursery at Stone Farm to grow a wider range of native species including narrow leaf milkweed, native grasses, sedges and rushes in order to diversify our restoration projects.

### **Endangered Species**

• Planning was initiated for the removal of trash and woody debris from the lower Laguna channel north of Guerneville Road. The eventual restoration of this important segment of the Laguna is critical to the migration of endangered salmon and steelhead.

• We completed our 9th year of the Adopt a Vernal Pool (AVP) Program. As the longest running, most comprehensive native plant assessment program in Sonoma County, the AVP program collects data to monitor and protect three endangered plant species in the Laguna Watershed.

• We received additional funding to continue our management work on a Sonoma County Regional Parks property between Hwy 12 and Occidental Road. This property has some of the last remaining populations of Sebastopol meadowfoam which had been in decline but is now recovering thanks to a combination of mowing and careful treatment of invasive pepperweed.

#### Groundwater Resources

• We were involved in creating the Santa Rosa Plain Watershed Groundwater Management Plan. Specifically we provided expertise to the Technical Advisory Committee of the Basin Advisory Panel which will determine how to monitor and sustainably manage our groundwater. In the coming year the Technical Advisory Committee will apply for funding to establish both a well monitoring and a seepage monitoring program. Once funded, we will be involved in implementing these programs.

### **Climate Adaptation**

• We worked with the North Bay Climate Adaptation Initiative (NBCAI) to plan and implement a conference at Sonoma State University and a Forum at the Laguna Environmental Center that brought together community leaders to discuss climate adaptation strategies.

• We secured funds for the second phase of a restoration project on Colgan Creek. Urban greening is particularly important in areas like Southwestern Santa Rosa where there are few parks and the urban heat island effect is strongest.

#### Learning Laguna

Learning Laguna is the only program for elementary school students focused on the Laguna de Santa Rosa's interwoven mosaic of habitats. Since its inception in 1999, over 15,000 second through fourth graders throughout the watershed have experienced the dynamic classroom activities and engaged their senses while observing, interacting, questioning and learning about the Laguna, their home environment.

The teachers tell us that their students gain an understanding of the Laguna and why it is such an important part of Sonoma County, and that the program fits in perfectly with their Life Science and Social Studies curriculum. However, it is when the students tell us that they want to bring their families to the Laguna and teach them all about the Laguna, that we know the program truly meets its goals!

Learning Laguna remains strong and vibrant due to the thousands of hours the Docents contribute to teaching the program. In the 2014-15 school year they worked with 48 classes, in 19 schools, within 12 school districts, serving nearly 1,300 students.

This year we are on target to bring the program to over 1,500 students in 55 classes. This increase is thanks to the dedication of long-serving volunteers and the addition of the 2015 Docent training graduates.

Twenty-two new Docents came on board this year. We look forward to increasing service to schools for years to come, engendering a love of the Laguna in the next generation of Sonoma County citizens.

#### **Public Education Programs**

In addition to the Laguna Environmental Center being open for the enjoyment of the community, each month we offer multiple indoor and outdoor learning adventures for diverse audiences that help inspire appreciation for the Laguna.

During the last fiscal year, approximately 2,100 people participated in the extensive selection of 48 Laguna walks, talks, classes, Environmental Center Open Houses, and art receptions in Heron Hall. These programs are exciting "points-of-entry" to the Laguna and the Foundation's work, attracting long-devoted and new community members alike. Many events are offered in partnership with local agencies or other non-profits, broadening our reach into the community. The Laguna Guide volunteers contribute to the success of each program by engaging visitors, teaching about the Laguna and the Foundation, and managing the site.

Additionally, Heron Hall was rented twenty-six times over the year to regional professional groups for trainings, workshops and educational retreats. Over 2,300 people came to the Laguna Environmental Center through the rental program, creating more outreach opportunities for the Foundation.

In the coming year, look for more walks to explore the watershed further, including visits to sites with completed and on-going restoration projects. Opportunities for all ages to learn from Docents, Guides, staff, board members, plus local and visiting experts will cover a spectrum of topics from Laguna flora and fauna (of course!) plus wide-ranging subjects from astronomy, geology, hydrology, and anthropology, to native plant use and botanical illustration. Be on the look out for sunrise, sunset and after dark explorations!

During the 2013-2014 fiscal year, **252 volunteers** contributed their time and skill in our restoration, education, and development departments. To all of our docents, guides, interns, tree planters, debris and weed removers, plant monitors, landscapers, special event and office support, Laguna Keepers and Team Prunus... we are grateful for your support.
